Conservancy supporters enjoyed an evening of delicious small plate summer fare from Bon Appetit in Angola, rocking music from the "Midwest Originals" from Indianapolis, friendly but fierce bidding at the Silent Auction and lively (and generous) bidding on five Live Auction items! We were especially happy to partner with the Yacht Club Ski Club on the VIP Ski Show Experience in the Live Auction to benefit TWO awesome organizations.

The attendees, plus a few "remote bidders" who were unable to attend, helped raise over \$50,000 for the Conservancy's long-term mission of preserving, protecting and maintaining land in the Clear Lake Watershed and Township for future generations. We are immensely grateful for this support and will be good stewards of every dollar in achieving this mission. We are also grateful for the joy of seeing community members have a wonderful evening welcoming the summer.

All of us are painfully aware of the loss of several community members over the past months. Events like SummerFest encourage us to appreciate our time together in this special place of natural beauty. Events like this also encourage us to remember those who are no longer with us. Many of you have remembered the lives of our departed friends and neighbors with memorials to the Conservancy. Thank you for celebrating their lives for years to come through our mission.

Hours of planning and effort go into community gatherings like SummerFest 2019. Our volunteers, sponsors, donors, and bidders are listed in this issue of *Clear Thinking*. It's a mighty team effort! We thank them and encourage you to pass along an "atta boy/girl" as you see them. The volunteers and Board also want to recognize Executive Director Bridget Harrison and our newest staff member, Tracy Hughes, for their commitment and enthusiasm for the Conservancy's work and mission. Kudos!

What else have we accomplished lately? Oh, just a few things! The three year shoreline restoration project at Kasota Island Nature Preserve is wrapping up. Our <u>regular updates</u> have reported that the protective fencing is down on the west, north and south sides. The east side preservation is complete. Once the new native plants get established, we'll remove the remaining fencing and begin monitoring the result on the pre-project erosion rate of 2-4 inches a year. Help us keep the glacial stones and plants in place. We expect the erosion to slow considerably.

The trails at Brennan Woods in the Clear Lake Nature Preserve are complete except for the boardwalk (or bridge, if Bridget has her way!) over the wetland. Progress continues on the west end of the preserve. The wood piles scattered across the prairie will soon be chipped with help from the Northeast Solid Waste Management District's gigantic chipper. It's a win/ win since we'll then use the woodchips on our trails and in other property maintenance. This winter the prairie will be seeded with natives.

Remember that John Deere Gator you've heard about from the SummerFest Live Auction? We're thrilled to report that it was generously contributed to the Conservancy! It will be a workhorse for us in our land stewardship work. The donation was a Wish List come true! We are grateful and will use it for years to come to support our mission.

Your support is irreplaceable for the Conservancy. We encourage you to walk the trails. Enjoy Kasota Island with family and friends. Appreciate the water quality of the Lake and the health of the wetlands and ditches that feed the Lake. Your support makes it happen. How about volunteering with us? You may get to drive the Gator!
