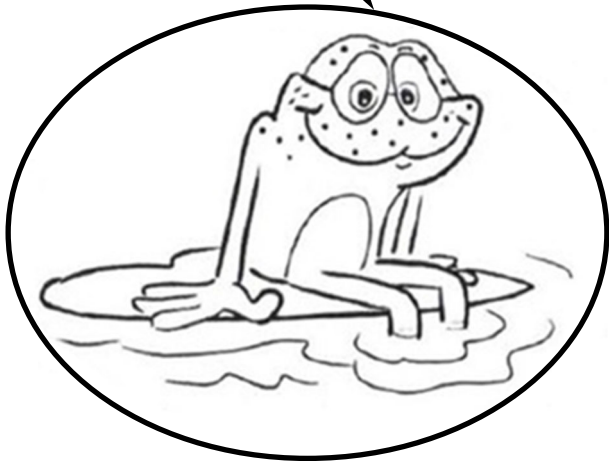
Friday, July 23rd – Mason Bees
