PARTY INVITATION



Updates are posted regularly on our website.





The Kasota Island Restoration Project taught us that shorelines are highly vulnerable to erosion. The Shoreline Survey, sent in the Clear Lake Association Spring newsletter, available on our website and through the QR code, will help us know where and how we can best partner with landowners to reduce erosion. WATERSHED DIAGNOSTIC STUDY (WDS)
